


# Where is hProxyN?



# Reading Configuration

- XML-based configuration file
- Strongly-typed classes derived from  
`System.Configuration.ConfigurationElement`
- Managed by CLR

# Processing Requests



# Request Cycle

- Similar to Apache HTTP Server
- `hProxyN.HttpWorker.ProcessRequest`
  - parsing phase
    - build url from `HttpListenerRequest`
  - security phase
    - Access Control goes here
  - preparation phase
  - handler phase
    - `HttpProxy` sends inbound request here

# Plugin Operations

- Implementing a plugin
  - Derive from hProxyN.PluginBase
  - Define a constructor taking a ConfigurationElement
  - Override AddHooks, listen to some events
  - Override RemoveHooks, stop listening

# Plugin Operations

- RequestListener raise events
  - Events about the listener itself
    - ListenerStart
    - ListenerStop
    - ListenerGotRequest
  - Events about a request
    - TranslateUrl – parsing phase
    - AccessControl – security phase
    - Prepare – preparation phase
    - Handler – handler phase
